#### **Second Hand Uniforms:**

- Dates TBC but hoping to do a stocktake in week 8 and hold a uniform sale in week 9, likely to be Friday 10<sup>th</sup> March
- There has been a generous donations of second hand uniform. Sorting is done once a term prior to a sale.
- The uniforms are kept packed away at the school and it is becoming increasingly difficult to meet individual requests during the week, as it is not manned like a shop. For this reason uniforms will only be available for purchase at the second hand uniform sales.

# **OLA Family Fiesta**

- The Fiesta will be held on Sunday 6<sup>th</sup> August. This year is the 10 year celebration of OLA parish
- 50% of money raised will go into the P&F account. Last year almost \$43,000 was raised of which \$ 21,464.97 was given to school.

- The school build is almost at completion credit to the building team who worked tirelessly over the holidays in extreme weather conditions.
- The school library is almost ready to be handed over.
- The final stages include OLA Street and the tree house building and will be completed in the next school holidays.
- 3 Key Goals / focus areas this year are:
  - Religion Where is God?
  - Literacy Writing and building further on reading skills and strong focus on spelling.
     Following on the success of 'OLA's Got Talent' looking at introducing a Spelling Bee across the grades.
  - Numeracy Multiplication and Division

# **GENERAL BUSINESS**

# Pergola / Picnic Sheds

## Motion to donate \$15,000 towards the construction of 3 pergolas / picnic sheds

- Upon presentation of the quotes to build 3 pergolas / picnic shelters a vote was held and it was agreed in favour by all in attendance to move that a donation of an initial \$15,000 be made to the school towards the cost of the build. A further donation may be made if more funds are needed when a quote has been decided upon with the final costs known.

# **P&F Annual General Meeting**

#### Motion to move AGM for 2018 from Term 2 to Term 1.

- It was proposed by Annemarie Bond to bring the P&F Annual General Meeting forward to term 1 2018 from term 2. Traditionally the AGM has been held in term 2 each year.
   Bringing the meeting forward to term 1 makes planning for the year ahead easier for the incoming P&F team.
- A vote was held and all in attendance agreed to move AGM in future, beginning in 2018, to term one.

# **SRC and Principals Award**

- Clarification around the process for selection for SRC and Principals award and how often this can be awarded. Eva advised the following
- SRC Eva advised the policy can be found on the school website and confirmed:
  - All children are given the opportunity to run for SRC
  - 1 boy and 1 girl from each class in each grade is elected for the SRC
  - SRC representatives are voted for by the students of that class
  - The votes are counted by the Assistant Principal
  - Students are eligible to run for SRC every 2<sup>nd</sup> year
- Principals Award
  - 1 student from each class group is selected by the class teacher to receive the principals award each term
  - Students are able to receive the award once in infants (K-2) and once in Primary (3-6)
- Discussion was held around the SRC and how more opportunities could be created for more students to be given an opportunity.
- It was suggested that SRC recipients could be aligned with the Principals award children can only be an SRC representative once in infants and once primary.
- Eva agreed to table the class SRC process with the Leadership team that this policy would be reviewed and presented at the next P&F meeting.

#### Canteen

- It has not been confirmed if the canteen will be ready for term 2, it is not looking likely.
- The canteen will be outsourced and not run by parent volunteers
- The management of the canteen will be decided via tender process which will be issued and managed by the CEDP.

## **School Crossing and Car Park**

- Discussion was held around parking in the school car park and people parking in 'NO PARKING' areas. Council are active in the area and will fine people parked in 'NO PARKING' areas.
- The parking area is particularly busy at the moment and this will slow down in the coming weeks as new children settle in.
- It was suggested that a volunteer each morning from 8.25 8.40am to man the crossing in the kiss and drop drive through would be ideal. If anyone is able to help please contact Eva.

# Suggestion Box / Parent Survey:

- A survey will be sent out by the P&F out to get feedback from parents in regard to community involvement etc.

# Plan for event helpers for 2017:

- A plan was presented by the P&F to help share the workload that goes into organising and running social and fund raising events.
- The P&F will still organise, coordinate and oversee the events with each grade being assigned an event to organise volunteers. This means each grade will only be involved in one key event rather then 10 different events each year.
