100 Kindergarten Enrolment applications received (50% new/50% siblings)

- Kindergarten Open Evening
 - A positive response to the open evening. The new parents were blown away by the classrooms and were excited by the open learning concept.
 - Many were complimentary of the leaders and guides on the night noting how engaging and mature they were. These are life skills Thank you!
- Playground
 - The school is reviewing the current playgrounds and has engaged a company to review the available spaces. Games and markings on the school grounds are being explored. There is also a review of a Natural playground, logs, dry creek bed and a Sensory garden. The school will discuss ideas and locations with Father Warren.
