With this in mind, I feel it is important to remind all members of our school community about some important communication protocols. I raise this matter with the wellbeing of all members of our school community as my central concern.

I am aware there is a number of Facebook pages that have been created by parents. While I am aware these pages have been created with the intention of staying connected with other members of the school community, I want to make clear these are not official school sites. These sites cannot use the school's name, logo or any of the school's branding. The school's website, its Facebook page and the Skoolbag app are the sources of truth for information about the school.

While I am sure that it would not happen intentionally, there have been examples recently of an unfortunate or misplaced comment or picture posted on a social media site like Facebook causing distress to a member or members of our community.

The welfare of each member of our school community is everyone's responsibility, so I ask that we all do everything possible to engage online with each other in a way that is always respectful, and acknowledges the dignity of every person. No social media site should ever be used to criticise teachers, students or other parents. Please think carefully before posting a comment online to avoid causing hurt or embarrassment. I also remind everyone that individuals are <u>not allowed</u>, by law, to publish images of other students or teachers.

I appreciate there can be a variety of views about particular issues. I urge anyone who has a concern to approach the school directly so the matter can be addressed appropriately.
